

BEYOND ANGKOR EXPEDITION *includes sunrise DEPART 0500 - RETURN 11.30

We highly recommend an early (5am) departure by Remork convoy for a pre-dawn drive through the forests towards Angkor Wat's East Gate. A stunning introduction to the Temples of Angkor, led by torchlight, we walk in the dark through the secluded East Gate to Angkor Wat itself.

One very personal way to experience the spirituality of Angkor in even more depth is to participate in a Buddhist blessing ceremony. A monk blessing is a tradition that dates back hundreds of years in Cambodia, and is performed for special occasions and auspicious dates. We arrange this solemn experience in a private location within Angkor Wat on a request basis.

After exploring Angkor Wat we continue on road to Sra Srang (the baray, or reservoir of Angkor), to an exquisite traditional Khmer Wooden House for a full deluxe Khmer breakfast with fresh coffee and juice.

After breakfast, we will visit the monumental magnificence of Angkor Thom - last capital of the Khmers. After passing through the South Gate, you will go down along this shady road to the stunning Bayon temple. We will tour through the Bayon, a 12th century masterpiece which lies at the very centre of Angkor Thom and which is an archaeological wonder of symmetry and grandeur.

Continue to Ta Prohm, the 'Jungle Temple' that has been left largely in it's natural state since its 're-discovery' by French explorers. Surrounded by jungle, its labyrinth of stone hallways is overgrown with the roots and limbs of massive banyan trees, which envelop the stone like tentacles.

LUM ORNG FARM TO TABLE RESTAURANT

Cambodia's first farm-to-table restaurant. Lum Orng is located in a village on the edge of Siem Reap. Here, owner-chef Sothea Seng cooks innovative Khmer cuisine, based on seasonal produce from his farms, local markets, and growers across the region

Lum Orng represents a renewal for the chef in terms of both his desire to develop an inventive new Mekong Cuisine that reflects Cambodia's long rich culinary history, and the expansion of his farm-to-table philosophy and commitment to sustainability with the establishment of a restaurant with herbs growing in the garden and a farm across the road.

The rural setting and isolation from the town and tourist strip ensures a meal at Lum Orng is met with style, Khmer charm and traditional design with a fine dining experience.

CATERED PICNIC LUNCH OR AFTERNOON COCKTAILS AT A SECRET TEMPLE RUIN DEPART 1100 - RETURN 1430 / 1600 - 1800

Today late morning (or late afternoon), we depart our hotel riding pillion on a Vespa behind your driver

As we leave the town behind, we are enveloped by the lush greenery of the Cambodian countryside. We will pass by rice paddies, fruit trees, and villages. Here we see people working in the fields, children playing, and animals grazing. Your travel expert is there to add insight to the sights sounds and smells of the surrounding rural areas.

As we ride further off the beaten track we arrive at our destination: a secret temple ruin completely unknown to tourists and barely known by the locals.

We park the Vespa and climb off, stretching your legs. We are surrounded by the temple ruins, which are bathed in golden light.

Arriving at the deserted ruins, a wooden platform covered in comfortable cushions and a table setting up has been prepared for us to enjoy a delicious picnic lunch that has been prepared privately for our group.

As we hear from our Travel Expert or local Khmer historian on the fascinating history of the site and tales of the Angkorean kingdom we dine on Khmer curry, which is a flavourful and aromatic dish made with chicken or beef, vegetables, and coconut milk

We then enjoy spring rolls, which are crispy and savoury pastries filled with meat, vegetables, and spices. For dessert, partake in fresh fruit, such as mangoes, papayas, and bananas. Relax on the lounge set up and enjoy free-flow drinks, including soft drinks, local beer, and wine. (champagne option), taking in the views of the temple ruins and the surrounding countryside.





OFF ROAD QUAD ADVENTURE

DEPART 14.30 - RETURN 17.30

Safe and fun an off road adventure on Quads is the best way to discover the countryside and remote villages around Siem Reap, taking you to places no one else does! This activity is suitable for everyone, with or without driving experience and is led by an experienced guide, respectful of the villagers and their environment.

Note: At the moment there are 25 quads, which can take a maximum of 2 pax per quad but the total weight can't exceed 130 kg per quad.

HALF DAY KULEN ELEPHANT SANCTUARY DEPART 0800 - RETURN 14:00

In the foothills of Kulen Mountain, lie 1100 acres of protected forest inhabited by the 14 elephants of Angkor. For 22 years, these elephants had given rides to visitors in the temples of the world heritage site. Today, they roam free in their natural habitat and are living testimony of a changing world. Here in the forest, they can finally roam free and unburdened. They have been allowed to rediscover relationships, natural foods, and receive the best of care.

The sanctuary's mission is to provide the elephants with a happy and comfortable retirement but also to offer a fun, educational approach to elephant conservation and contribute to preserving the remaining elephants of Cambodia.

Upon arrival we spend our time observing the elephants as they enjoy their natural surroundings.

Walk with them into the forest, and witness how they choose to spend their time. A carer is on hand to explain more about the animals and the role of conservation in Cambodia.

HALF DAY ANGKOR TRAILS BY VESPA & BICYCLE DEPART 0800 - RETURN 12:00

Depart the hotel for an exhilarating drive riding pillion on Vespas as we head into Angkor. We pass through Angkor Thom marvelling at the Bayon in the morning light. We drive through what is known as the "Grand Circuit" to our first stop - is Preah Khan Temple.

Preah Khan is one of the most significant buildings erected during the ancient Khmer empire. Dedicated by the great king Jayavarman VII to his father in 1191, Preah Khan serves today as an outstanding example of a large linear temple complex in a dense jungle setting. The WMF (World Monuments Fund) are currently engaging in some restoration work here and, upon a very special request, we can organise a behind the scenes visit with the local WMF Archaeological expert, Cinevra Boatto.

After our Preah Khan experience, we return to the Grand Circuit road and exchange our vespas for bicycles as we ride along cycle marked paths nestled in the forest.

Built by Jayavarman VII before the end of the 12th century, this monument – Neak Pean or the entwined naga – is an artificial island, measuring 350 meters on each side, built in the middle of a reservoir which is also man made.

After Neak Pean we climb back aboard our Vespas and continue with an exhilarating ride around the rest of the Grand Circuit road to the lesser visited Banteay Kdei temple. Banteay Kdei is a charming ancient temple located opposite the grand basin of Srah Srang to which it was once connected.

Return by vespa to our hotel thereafter.

PREAH KHAN KOMPONG SVAY









DELUXE CAMPING AT PREAH KHAN KOMPONG SVAY

After lunch we depart Siem Reap for our scenic helicopter flight to remote Preah Khan Kompong Svay. We step off the helicopter in the mid afternoon onto a plush landing pad, and are immediately greeted by the sight of a luxurious camp nestled in the jungle. The tents are spacious and comfortable, and they are equipped with all the amenities you need for a relaxing stay. After being shown to your tent, we take a moment to relax and unwind.

Located within short walking distance lies the temple itself - a remarkable isolated site that was once as grand as Angkor itself.

Preah Khan of Kompong Svay (not be mistaken with Preah Khan temple in Angkor), is a remote archeological site located 200 km from Siem Reap Because of its remote location it receives less than 20 visitors daily if that. The layout of the temple is unique compared to the other sites in Angkor as it is oriented northeast. It has been proposed that the temple is aligned with the raising sun during thee summer solstice.

Exploring the site can be quite difficult because of the dense vegetation and the absence of clear paths but this all adds to the rich sense of exploration.


In the evening we are treated to a delicious Khmer cuisine tasting menu. The food is prepared by a team of award-winning chefs, and it is presented in a tasteful Khmer style. We enjoy the 5 course tasting dinner with a glass of local beer, wine, or perhaps a bottle of champagne. In the evening, we gather around the campfire for a night of storytelling and music.

Start your sensory experience with a visit to Psar Cha, the local market in the centre of town. The market sells hand woven silks, silver and wooden carved products and jewellery. You will also get a glimpse into the daily life of Cambodians when passing the food section where sellers will try to make you buy a diverse varity of fresh fruits or vegetables.

After your market visit, visit one of the most relaxing places in Siem Reap; the Bodia Spa. This spa is dedicated to pampering both body and soul while using only natural, Cambodian-made products. You will have the choice between traditional massages such as foot reflexology, a head, back & shoulder massage, Bodia Tonic or an Aromatherapy Massage.

During your treatment cold beer, wine or champagne can be served to enjoy as you relax and unwind after an active few days exploring the temples.

VISIT OF SATCHA CENTER & LOCAL MARKET DEPART 1500 - RETURN 18:00

SATCHA is a brand-new Cambodian handicraft visitor centre that mixes traditional knowledge with contemporary design to showcase Cambodian talents while having a sustainable social, economic, and environmental impact. Created as a lifeline for Cambodian artisans whose livelihoods were devastated by the pandemic, SATCHA is an 'Incubation Centre' that empowers talented people, offers further training, provides them with sustainable work and income, and provides them with entrepreneurship training to help them set up on their own terms in the future.

Located in a beautifully lush, one-hectare site, SATCHA includes six large workshops that represent the different arts and craft of Cambodia, these include wood and stone carving, silk works, weaving, etc. The unique design was developed by a company whose mission it is to revive the sustainable bamboo value chain in Cambodia. Each workshop is set among a lush rice field, the structure is a stunning creation with a sweeping roof made from intricately woven bamboo.

A bamboo walkway meanders through the workshops (where one can meet and watch the artisans at work) leading to the beautiful concept store that sells quality ethical products from around Cambodia as well as items made on site. The attractive coffee and juice bar serves refreshments, wine, and cocktails.

Continue on to the **Old Market** in the center of Siem Reap. The Old Market (also knows as 'phsa cha') offers great opportunities for souvenir shopping but also to see or buy traditional fruits, Cambodian desserts or spices.

SECRET TEMPLE SITE

IEM REAF

Within Siem Reap town and next to its river, lies a vibrant working Pagoda. Surrounded by trees and also a local school, this is arguably the most atmospheric Pagoda in Siem Reap, yet is completely off the tourist trail.

The temple grounds are peaceful and tranquil, with lush greenery and towering sandstone structures. Whilst a relatively small temple, it is well-preserved and has some beautiful features. The temple is made of sandstone and features a number of intricate carvings. The main sanctuary of the temple is topped by a five-tiered roof.

Monks in their orange saffron robes appear from the alcoves of the ruins chanting a blessing in Pali (Buddhist language) as guests make their way to their tables. An evening of fine dining Khmer cuisine is prepared under an evocative backdrop of both the ruins and the modern day pagoda behind it.

The setting is ideal for a genteel performance of Khmer dance and art or a string quartet. For something more energetic, the Phare Cambodia circus can perform on the natural stage beside the ruins.
