UBUD ARRIVAL

PADDIES & PEDDLES – A DOWNHILL CYCLE RIDE FROM KINTAMANI TO UBUD DEPART: 08.30 / RETURN 14:00

Transfer to the cooler climates of Batur Village, where your cycling guide will meet you.

Enjoy a refreshing cup of tea at a local restaurant and take in the beautiful countryside views as your guide briefs you about today's cycling tour. We will set off on a leisurely downhill bike ride from Batur to Ubud using modern and well-equipped mountain bikes.

The first stop is a local temple where your Balinese guide will introduce you to Hinduism and its importance in the day-to-day lives of the Balinese people.

The tour then takes us on a journey through peaceful countryside villages, where you can witness the various agricultural communities tending to their crops.

A pop up picnic/snack set up is found in the middle of the countryside where refreshments are served and maybe, just maybe, a glass of wine or a refreshing beer!

Using quiet backroads and small paths across rice fields and plantations, we can take in the countryside air and enjoy the slower pace of life before reaching Ubud, where our tour concludes at one of the town's famous cafes.

Note: The cycling distance can be shortened to commence at a halfway point or any distance required. Electric bikes are also available but need to be used on a different route.

Option to end the activity with Afternoon Tea at Embers Farm.

PRIVATE TEMPLE KECAK FIRE DANCE PERFORMANCE

UBUD (UNDISCLOSED LOCATION)

In the late afternoon (1600 depart) we drive through the backroads of Ubud to a local village temple that has been exclusively reserved for our group.

Under a tented canopy in the main courtyard we are served refreshments and receive an introduction and educational briefing on the performance we are about to see as the sun goes down.

Kecak dance is said to originate from a Balinese ancient ritual called Sanghyang, aimed as a form of exorcism or to repel evil spirits in which dancers fall into a trance. The dance first appeared in 1930, after Balinese dancer, Wayan Limbak worked together with German painter Walter Spies to create a dramatic performance by incorporating the epic Ramayana saga.

Whilst the dance of Kecak is arguably Bali's most popular and recognised, it can be seen in various forms on the island.

Rather than deliver a typical 'tourist' experience the troupe that perform in this private location are considered the most professional and dedicated to their art, containing some 60 individuals that deliver the most enthralling spectacle.

The drama builds as male members of the troupe shoot fire from their mouths into the air keeping the evil spirits at bay. An amazing human voiced orchestra is led by a soloist, who is in charge of indicating the high and low notes, and also acts as narrator. The effect, after a while, is to provide a wall of dramatic sound against which the action of the play is enacted.

DINNER OPTION: MOZAIC or EMBERS UBUD DINING

Mozaic Restaurant is one of the 'oldest' gastronomic restaurants in Ubud. It is located near the centre on a beautiful property which features a large bar at the entrance, an indoor and outdoor dining area, and a private pavilion out in the garden with its beautiful setting between green surroundings and atmospheric, dimmed lighting.

At Mozaic, South-East Asian flavours still form the basis for each dish. International, luxurious ingredients like truffle, lobster and foie gras are merged with local Indonesian flavours and prepared with European techniques. Interested in a more exclusive dining experience? By special arrangement, Mozaic offers private dinners with the chef in the dining room adjacent their teaching kitchen. You can opt for a surprise or collaborate with the chef to create your own menu.

Unlike anything else in Ubud, Embers Restaurant is all about celebrating Mediterranean traditions in all aspects of the dining experience, from the craft of fine cooking (and the drool-worthy menus to boot), to the company of good people in a stunningly contemporary space, and the night's sky dancing above.

And the kicker? The ingredients used in each sublimely-presented dish are freshly harvested and grown earth-to-table on the restaurant's very own organic farm, paired with locally-sourced meat and seafood and a fabulous drinks list that pays tribute to the spirit and flavours of The Med.

The Telaga Waja river is classified as rapids level II-IV, making it more exciting and challenging than its more commercial, and heavily touristed Ayung River, near Ubud.

After periods of rain it is a 20kms stretch of constant rapids and white water, making it well worth the extra effort to get here. On some days we might well be the only group rafting!

The lush, heavily forested scenery is sublime and the sheer towers of vegetation is visually striking. It is very much Bali as it used to be and still is in these parts.

At the end of our river exploration we break for food and drink in a garden setting overlooking the river before we return to our van to climb out of the valley.

What better way to return to Ubud than by helicopter, flying over the river that we have just navigated and past spectacular mountain scenery, before landing at Ubud's only landing pad at the Viceroy Resort. From there, vehicles await to whisk us back to our hotel for the evening.



QUAD BIKE ADVENTURE

DEPART 14:00 / RETURN 17:00

We head further into the hills and bucolic countryside of Gianyar Regency to a Quad Bike base for an afternoon of fun and adventure.

The quad bikes are professionally maintained and the team behind this activity ensures safety comes first. A trail run and lesson are conducted before hand.

We then commence to enter the jungle encroached valley as we conquer muddy terrain, transverse bamboo forests and enter viaducts and tunnels submerged in water. As we exit the tunnel we drive under waterfalls flowing down from the cliffs for a refreshing natural shower.

But it is not just the terrain we cover that captures our adventurous spirit but also the plantations and villages that see few foreign visitors in this part of Bali coupled with the gorgeous panoramic views of the hills and mountains

We recommend regular t-shirt and shorts for this excursion as all guests are guaranteed to get wet and muddy, although showers and changing rooms with fresh towels are available upon our return to base.


Today's program will take you on a journey to discover the spiritual side and central area of Bali. The program will start at the Taman Beji Griya waterfall, a relatively unknown waterfall that was only recently opened to the general public. The area will be privatised for your visit.

Led by a local priest you will partake in a purification ceremony (Melukat), which consists of 4 stages. The Melukat involves chanting, offerings, meditation, prayer, and a ritualistic bath in the holy spring water, known as "Tirta". Holy water forms the basis for a large number of rites and rituals in Bali, including christenings, cremations and numerous Hindu occasions.

After melukat finishes, drying off and changing your clothes, we depart for Sangeh Monkey Forest. Meet more than hundreds of long-tailed monkey is this 10 hectares area that is dominated by beautiful Nutmeg Trees.




