














PRUEK YACHT CHARTER

Immerse your event in the enchanting ambiance of the Chao Phraya River aboard the Pruek Yacht in Bangkok. A unique floating venue, it offers an unparalleled experience combining luxury, culture, and the mesmerizing river's allure. Built almost entirely out of teak wood the yacht has been designed to demonstrate the classic and timeless Thai aesthetic.

Stepping on board, guests are first accommodated at the horseshoe-shaped, marbletopped Champagne bar, stocked exclusively by Piper-Heidsieck.

Drinks in hand, guests make their way across the first floor, which opens up into a luxurious airconditioned lounge room with wall-to-wall glass windows for sweeping views of the city and its ever active river life. For those that prefer the open outdoors, the yacht's upper deck can also be used for dining. Cuisine served on board matches the elegant decor and levels of luxury with dishes created by Bangkok based Michelin starred chefs, all customised to personal tastes and preferences.

The spacious and opulently designed interiors of the Pruek Yacht can effortlessly accommodate a large guest list while preserving an atmosphere of exclusivity. For medium sized incentive programs or a corporate event, there is no vessel quite like it on the Chao Praya River.

BANGKOK BACKWATERS DEPART 0800 / RETURN 1200

This morning, we start our journey with a visit to Wat Ratchabophit. Built in 1896, this is the first temple with a mixture of fine local and western styles: colorful tiled rooftops, golden spires, and vaulting structures reminiscent. From here, we venture to one of the oldest fresh markets in old Bangkok and watch the locals doing their morning shopping while sampling local snacks as we walk from stall to stall.

Then, we continue to visit Wat Suthat, one of the oldest and most impressive temples in Bangkok. It has an elegant prayer hall with sweeping roofs, magnificent murals, and exquisite hand-carved teakwood door panels. Afterwards, we walk along Buddha Street while making our way to the 'Golden Mountain'. Wat Sakret is one of the city's oldest temples and an iconic landmark, once being the highest point in Bangkok. The steep hill is topped with a golden stupa, containing relics of the Buddha that were brought over from India.

We hop on a local Tuk-Tuk to Nang Loeng market where you can find the capital's very best street food scene. We board a colorful long-tailed boat that will take us along the banks of the Chao Phraya River. Thonburi is considered one of the oldest neighborhoods and stands in great contrast to modern Bangkok with its traditional Teak houses on stilts built all along the canals.

On the return journey we will make a short stop at Wat Arun (Temple of Dawn) whose magnificent multicolored porcelain-studded towers has become the visual identity of Bangkok, always pictured with the Chao Praya River in the foreground.

CHINATOWN CHOW

This afternoon, we explore the diverse markets Bangkok has to offer – We make our way from a local fresh market to a wholesale market, followed by a community market until we reach a famous night market. Along the way, we will experience the daily life of the locals, learn more about the importance of these markets and sample some iconic dishes along the way. We start walking along Yaowarat Street which is home to a slew of gold shops, Chinese herb shops, food stalls, and Chinese restaurants during the daytime. Followed by Sampeng Market, the oldest wholesale market in Bangkok, where many small traders buy their stock. It will give you a good insight into the cast

array of products sold throughout Thailand. As the journey continues, we will cross the first street of Bangkok, Charoen Krung to visit Wat Mangkon Kamalawat – the largest and most important Chinese temple in Bangkok. This temple is busy all day with locals coming to make merit and pray for health and wealth. A narrow walking street will lead us to Charoen Chai Community where residents have been crafting traditional Chinese joss paper for over a century. In addition, they also produce the shiny gold and red envelopes used for gift-giving during the Chinese lunar new year.


We soon reach our starting point at Yaowarat Street which transformed itself into an evening night market with food stalls lined up on both sides. And if that was not enough, we will head into the hidden backstreets/ back alleys to explore infinite food options of the area. After our exploration transfer back to the hotel or explore the area at your own pace.

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SIRI SALA GASTRONOMY DEPART 1.30PM - RETURN 2100

Ruen Deum at Siri Sala is located just to the right of the villa, also fondly known as the Heritage Bar. Prior to its construction, each piece of wooden panels from the old property was carefully marked and disassembled by craftsmen from Ayutthaya so that we could save most of the original materials.

Kick off the day by learning how to select the right ingredients for the day's dishes through Chef's introduction – you will also learn the culinary history of Thai dishes. 4 students will be provided with an individual cooking station and equipment, where you'll learn how to make three different Thai main dishes, a dessert as well as how to make curry paste from scratch! The instructors will tailor your experience to your culinary skill level, so everyone can follow along. Vegetarian dishes are also available, and special attention to allergies are made. Once you're done cooking, you get to feast on your creations.

Evening event OJO & SKYBEACH BAR

Towering above the metropolis of Bangkok are two of the trendiest venues in town. Located on the 78th floor of the striking Mahanakhon Building, Ojo serves unique Mexican cuisine and creative cocktails in a unique and vibrant setting. Taking its name from the Spanish word for "eye" – Ojo overlooks Bangkok as it serves Chef Paco Ruano's signature cuisine with a menu that combines traditional and contemporary Mexican techniques with a mix of imported and locally sourced ingredients to create incredible culinary flavors.

Ojo's rich, jewel-toned interior aesthetics take inspiration from the continent's precious metals and gemstones that drew prospectors in pursuit of riches to that part of the world. Also woven into the design are subtle references to the mysticism of Latin America's ancient civilizations. The result is a glamorous environment anchored by gold hues and offset by organic, gemstone tones creating a visual representation of an architectural crown jewel. Pre or Post dinner drinks will be served at the fashion forward Sky Beach Bar that holds the crown as the highest rooftop bar in the city, offering the commanding views that you would expect. It is the views of the Chao Phraya River off in the distance that impress the most; unbroken vistas of the "River of Kings" and its dramatic twists.

While the vistas are the prime feature, the retrochic, tropical and 'lots-of-yellow' decor is not far behind, including a phone booth and a very cool bar. Grab a seat in on of the loungers or on the majestic staircase, and tune out to live DJs and the views.

BANGKOK IMMERSION DEPART 0730 - 1200

This morning program is all about immersion into Bangkok's rich cultural aspects. Away from the tourist haunts, we start our day with a private Tai Chi class in the grounds of Lumpini Park. Surrounded by lush green vegetation in the beating heart of the metropolis we learn moves and exercises with our instructor to gain insight into the physical and mental benefits of this ancient form.

A private refreshment stand with cool drinks, coffee and tea is on hand to replenish lost energy!

Thereafter a convoy of tuk tuk's await with a police escort to whizz us across town to the Chao Praya riverside where we board elegant hacker river craft to take us across the river in style. At our drop off location we are met with bicycles to begin our exploration of suburban Bangkok backstreets on two wheels. As we cycle through laneways and along the canals we see the city of the past and where mass development has yet to encroach. Before the heat of the day starts to take its toll we rest in the shade of a delightful Buddhist temple.

Resident monks, in their deep orange robes, are there to greet us as they give their blessings to the health and well-being of their visitors. This is a solemn and spiritual experience and closes our morning with a feeling of peace and contentment.

Shortly thereafter we transfer to our restaurant for a sumptuous Thai meal.

Lunch option SUPANINGA EATING ROOM

Tucked at the end of Soi Penpat 1, Supanniga Eating Room x Roots Coffee is set in a two-story wooden house that's injected with touches of bright yellow, Supanniga's signature hue. Wood and terracotta is heavily used, presenting a stark contrast to the colorful cushions borrowed from the restaurant's sister cruise.

Inspired by the cuisine of the south-eastern Trat province and the northern Isaan region, the restaurant serves authentic Thai dishes inspired by the recipes of the owner grandmother.


As you might expect from the local cuisine, they are intensely colourful and photogenic, but for all of Supanniga's contemporariness, Eh wants to recreate the comforting nostalgia of homecooked meals: simple quality ingredients, and staying true to recipes handed down through generations. The coffee bar manned by Roots takes over the first floor, churning out caffeinated masterpieces, while a cocktail bar one floor above on the terrace offers stunning views of Wat Arun

With a unique long table setting, and with easy access by boat, this venue offers a creative, innovative venue that can be enhanced with entertainment and a contemporary menu for an interactive dining experience.


